

UPDATE (Monday, 3/16/2020):

Per the NBC Career Education Inclement Weather/Student Safety Policy, parents have the right to keep students home per their discretion at ANY time. Due to the (3/16/2020) cancellation of school from the COVID-19 virus pandemic, NBC Career Education students are NOT REQUIRED to attend ANY field experiences (including paid internships) until school is back in session.

However, students & their parent/guardian DO have the right to elect for a student to attend any field experiences they choose IF the community partner is still on board for hosting that experience/internship; when doing so, parents assume liability for that attendance. We ask that community partners follow updated state and federal fair labor standards and consider timely mandates from health officials regarding the latest updates on the pandemic, which can change hourly. Mrs. Wright is happy to assist in any questions regarding student interns at any time.

As always, COMMUNICATION IS KEY for everyone to be aware of the intentions for a planned experience for a student. Communicating a daily plan for attendance between the student, parent, community partner, and NBC's Cooperative Learning Coordinator Mrs. Wright will be the responsibility of the STUDENT.

Parents, Students, and Community Partners: Please know how much we appreciate your understanding our navigating the legal and educational ramifications of this unprecedented situation and how we MUST emphasize the importance of public health and safety alongside the valuable education we know our students can receive with these field experiences.
