- 1) We are in the process of calling parents who have a student with missing assignments. Please make sure your phone's voicemail box is set-up and not full as we've run into a number of issues making connections or leaving voicemail messages on cell phones.
- 2) Become an observer of your student's Canvas page! As with everything else these days, go to the school website. On the left side in big block letters is a graphic that says 'PARENTS: CLICK HERE to observe your student on canvas'. I think you will find it to be beneficial in charting your student's progress while also educational for you in learning how the Canvas program works.

- 3) Feel free to email teachers with questions or concerns. As a reminder, all employee email addresses can be found under the Parents tab or Students tab on the school website.
