This is a message to make you aware that a male student at North Bend Central Elementary tested positive for coronavirus. Confidentiality laws prohibit us from disclosing further information regarding the identity of the student but we did learn from the parent that the student is feeling better so that is very good news.

Earlier today, the parent notified a school official of the positive test result for coronavirus. Since then, we have been in contact with Three Rivers Health Department to initiate the contact tracing process. At this point in time, we believe a very limited number of students would be classified as Direct Contacts of the student and will need to quarantine.

A much larger number of students and staff become low-risk contacts of this student. They will have their temperature checked in the classroom tomorrow morning and asked if they are displaying any of the symptoms commonly associated with the coronavirus. School officials will be in touch with the parents of those students that are determined to be secondary contacts.

Again, NBC has its first student with positive confirmation of the coronavirus. The good news is that the parent kept their student at home once he became ill, worked well with the school from the outset, only a very small number of students need to quarantine, and that the student is feeling much better at this point in time.
