While both buildings continue to deal with a number of quarantines of students related to parents or siblings testing positive for the virus, the number of positive cases of students testing positive across the district within the past week was 4 while one employee tested positive. With three weeks worth of positive cases remaining manageable and with staff absences improving, the Coronavirus Committee of the Board moved the high school back into the Yellow column of the risk dial, which will now mirror the elementary school approach. As a reminder, Yellow is the color we've operated in for most of the school year and shows a higher level of confidence than the Orange column.

A few minor changes will be implemented into the high school day that will be communicated with students via the intercom Monday morning as we return to Yellow on the risk dial. Parents should not expect to see any significant modifications regarding the school day.
