- ✓ **All students will have an opportunity to apply for Character Council. Students will complete a written questionnaire during school regarding their good character, positive behaviors, and reason for wanting to be on Character Council. These questions will be answered on the worksheet provided and returned back to Mrs. Ferguson. After completing the interview questions students will be handed 2 evaluations that they will be responsible for having 2 staff members complete and return back to Mrs. Ferguson or Mrs. Sterup. All students will be considered for members. If there is a large enough commitment of members we will form into 2 different councils having meetings on different days.**
- ✓ **Character Council members model positive behaviors and good character for other students and must follow school rules.**
